A. Resolute Loyal Love - 1. Awake to Our Present Time - 101. The Blessings of Jesus

SUMMARY: Before we go into details, remember that whatever Jesus requires of you as His disciple, is actually meant for your own happiness.

Jesus is calling us to discipleship, so we may engage in the inevitable conflict and become more than conquerors through His own love (Rom 8:37). He promises us this victory and shows us how gain it – as the only way to true happiness now and for all eternity.

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus gives His inaugural address as the King of His new kingdom of divine grace (Mt 5:1-8:1; Lk 6:17-49). Right at its beginning (Mt 5:1-12), He "proclaims that the main objective of the kingdom is to restore the lost happiness of Eden to the hearts of men, and that those who choose to enter in by the 'strait' gate and the 'narrow' way (Matt. 7:13, 14) will find true happiness." (5BC 324).

In the book of Revelation, Jesus announces His soon return as the King of kings finally to establish His eternal kingdom of divine glory (Da 7:14). Throughout the book, He gives some more blessings and instructions to His beloved remnant people in these last days, so they may not only retain their happiness in the present kingdom of grace on earth, but also secure it for the soon coming kingdom of glory.

A. Sound the Trumpet – 1. Awake to Our Present Time – 102. The Ultimate Exodus

SUMMARY: The other good news is that in your training as a disciple, Jesus is actually preparing you for our ultimate exodus from this sinful world.

In anticipation of the rebellion of Lucifer and the resulting great controversy between Jesus and Satan (Eze 28:13-19; Isa 14:12-15; Rev 12:7-9), God conceived His gracious plan of our salvation through His Son (Mt 1:21; Jn 3:16) before Their creation of our world (Eph 1:4; 1 Pe 1:20; Rev 13:8). Ever since Adam's fall it has been God's goal, as illustrated in the earthly sanctuary, to free His people from the penalty, power, and then the presence of sin (Ge 3:15). In order to accomplish this plan, God provides several stages of freedom, each of which involves a delivery, or an exodus, of faithful believers from sin and/or sinners, through several events at different times in world history. Scripture relates these events to each other.

In the first instance, God gave humanity 120 years to repent of their wickedness (Ge 6:3), while faithful Noah was building the ark and warning his contemporaries of the coming destruction of the world through a global flood. Finally eight, this preacher of righteousness and his family, were saved (Ge 7:23; 2 Pe 2:5). The wickedness of humanity just prior to Jesus' second coming will be "as in the days of Noah" (Mt 24:37). Therefore, as the ark saved Noah from the worldwide flood, so today baptism upon conversion saves believers from the coming global fire (1 Pe 3:18-21; 2 Pe 3:9-12). Jesus' remnant has preached His righteousness for 120+ years, and also calls other believers to make their exodus from fallen Babylon.

The second historical event that typifies the plan of salvation, was the exodus of God's people from their slavery in Egypt and their journey to the prosperity and safety of the Promised Land (Ex 3:8, 17; Lev 20:24). But before the Israelites could be free, they were to eat unleavened bread, kill and eat a lamb without blemish, and apply its blood to their doorposts. Only then would the Lord pass over their dwellings, save them from destruction and enable their exodus from national slavery (Ex 12). Today, since Jesus our Passover is sacrificed, only those who claim His blood by faith and purge the old leaven of sin in their lives, are saved from spiritual slavery and final destruction (1 Co 5:7-8; Rom 3:25; 1 Pe 1:19; Rev 7:14; 20:15).

We are now on the verge of the ultimate exodus into freedom from the presence of sin, as we await and hasten the coming of Jesus. He will take His faithful ones to Himself into their eternal Promised Land (Jn 14:1-3; 2 Pe 3:13; Rev 21:1-7). Are we ready for our ultimate exodus?

A. Sound the Trumpet – 1. Awake to Our Present Time – 103. Prophetic Descriptions

SUMMARY: First then, you need absolute loyal love for Jesus, so you can be vigilant and remain faithful to Him in all aspects of our present time.

Our present time, the time of the end between 1844 and the close of human probation, has been announced and described prophetically in the Scriptures in various ways. All of these aspects point to a critical time of decision and division among God's people, and in the world due to their global witness (Mt 10:32-36; Lk 12:51; Rev 14:6-12; *LDE 172-173*). Soon the great controversy between Christ and Satan will reach its climax as people decide whether they take the mark of the beast or will be faithful to the end (Rev 14:9-12; 2:10).

We need to be awake to our present time so we will not be taken by surprise, but be found ready to be taken home (Rom 13:11; *PK* 626; Rev 19:7). We need to "be sober, be vigilant" so the roaring lion will not devour us (1 Pe 5:8). As always but especially in the last days, "Satan watches eagerly to find Christians off their guard. O that the followers of Christ would remember that eternal vigilance is the price of eternal life. Many have a slumbering faith. Unless they are invigorated, revived, quickened into action, their souls will be lost." (*UL* 200).

In short, our present time is the most crucial period in the history of the church and the world. The choices we make right now effect us eternally. The Scriptures describe ten aspects of our time relating to our conversion, conflict, and conquest.

A. Sound the Trumpet – 1. Awake to Our Present Time – 105. The One Issue of the Great Controversy

SUMMARY: Recall also that Satan hides his true issue and pretends that God's law is at fault. But Jesus and His disciples disprove his claims.

"From the very beginning of the great controversy in heaven it has been Satan's purpose to overthrow the law of God. It was to accomplish this that he entered upon his rebellion against the Creator, and though he was cast out of heaven he has continued the same warfare upon the earth. To deceive men, and thus lead them to transgress God's law, is the object which he has steadfastly pursued. Whether this be accomplished by casting aside the law altogether, or by rejecting one of its precepts, the result will be ultimately the same. He that offends 'in one point,' manifests contempt for the whole law; his influence and example are on the side of transgression; he becomes 'quilty of all.' James 2:10."

"In seeking to cast contempt upon the divine statutes, Satan has perverted the doctrines of the Bible, and errors have thus become incorporated into the faith of thousands who profess to believe the Scriptures. The last great conflict between truth and error is but the final struggle of the long-standing controversy concerning the law of God. Upon this battle we are now entering -- a battle between the laws of men and the precepts of Jehovah, between the religion of the Bible and the religion of fable and tradition. The agencies which will unite against truth and righteousness in this contest are now actively at work." (*GC* 582). Soon they will take legal action against God's law and people (Rev 13:15-17).

The actual issue behind the great controversy is Satan's pride and resulting envy of Christ (Isa 14:12-14; Eze 28:2-17; *GC* 494-495; *DA* 21-22). But in order to conceal and defend his true motive for his rebellion, and to gain followers among angelic and human beings, Satan projected his own characteristics on God, thus leading them to doubt His word and to distrust His goodness (Ge 3:1-5; *DA* 22; *GC* 495). "Unselfishness, the principle of God's kingdom, is the principle that Satan hates; its very existence he denies. From the beginning of the great controversy he has endeavored to prove God's principles of action to be selfish, and he deals in the same way with all who serve God. To disprove Satan's claim is the work of Christ and of all who bear His name." (*Ed* 154). The remnant people of God are called to help vindicate God and His law.

"It is only as the law of God is restored to its rightful position that there can be a revival of primitive faith and godliness among His professed people." (GC 478). Will God's people share in Christ's victory over Satan by obedience to His whole law?

A. Sound the Trumpet – 1. Awake to Our Present Time – 106. The Beast of the Great Controversy

SUMMARY: In order to trace Satan's activities throughout history, you identify him in the prophetic descriptions of Daniel and Revelation.

"The world has no just conception of Satan. He is not thought of as the prince of the world, the general of a vast rebellion, a being logical and philosophical, possessing a powerful intellect. But thus it is. The adversary of God and leader in the great controversy waged against the world's Redeemer, his deceptive powers have been sharpened by constant practice; and in the final crisis he will deceive to their own ruin those who do not now seek to understand his methods of working." (*RH 07-16-1901*). Daniel was shown the "nature of the beast" and his demonic activities as a sequence of 4 beasts, one with 10 horns and a little horn. Revelation depicts Satan three times as a composite beast with 7 heads and 10 horns.

God wants His people to have His wisdom to understand these things (Rev 13:18; 17:9). Are we asking for this wisdom (Jas 1:5)?

A. Sound the Trumpet – 1. Awake to Our Present Time – 108. The Seven Powers of the Great Controversy

SUMMARY: As you study the corporate level of Satan's rebellion, you see that we live under the final powers, 6 to 8. Jesus is soon to return!!

God and Satan pursue their great controversy also on the corporate level. Daniel and Revelation together reveal seven political powers before Christ's kingdom is established. Satan uses paganism or idolatrous nations with counterfeit religions, as well as apostasy or corruption of true religion, to try to force or deceive God's people into allegiance to him (*4BC 1163-1164*). Cooperation between church and state has often been Satan's means to accomplish his rebellious goal. On the other hand, God allows Satan's strategies to affect His people as a test of faith so He can preserve for Himself a faithful remnant, through which He reveals His truth and His power to save (Isa 10:22; Jer 23:3; Joel 2:32; Rom 11:5; Rev 12:17).

In "the rise and fall of empires...above, behind, and through all the play and counterplay of human interest and power and passions," we are to see "the agencies of the all-merciful One, patiently working out the counsels of His own will," the "manifestation of His power who 'removeth kings, and setteth up kings' (Daniel 2:21) – this is to understand the philosophy of history." (*Ed 173-175; PK 499-502*). But also, "for centuries satanic agencies have been at work. Will they now give up without a struggle?" (*7BC 985*). "Not without a struggle does Satan allow the kingdom of God to be built up in the earth. The forces of evil are engaged in unceasing warfare against the agencies appointed for the spread of the gospel..." (*AA 167*).

Therefore, "Let the people of God prepare for what is coming upon the earth." (7BC 985). Are we awake and willing to get ready? Are we equipped to fight the good fight of faith (1 Ti 6:12; Rev 14:12) as we share the last divine message of mercy with a dying world (Rev 14:6-11)?

A. Sound the Trumpet – 1. Awake to Our Present Time – 109. The Two Natures of the Great Controversy

SUMMARY: You then recognize how you participate in Satan's rebellion on the personal level, until you freely choose Jesus' divine nature.

Jesus and Satan fight on the cosmic level in direct confrontation in heaven (Rev 12:7) and on earth (Jude 9; Da 10:13; Mt 4:1-11), on the corporate level through religious idolatry/apostasy (12BC 982-989) and political powers (Rev 13), and on the personal level in each human heart (Ge 3:1-8; Lk 22:3; Jn 8:38-46; 16:8; Jas 1:13-15). "Within the domain of every human heart this controversy is repeated." (DA 116). Each level involves the same "two principles" or "antagonistic motives" that are "contending for supremacy...." (Ed 190). Therefore, every follower of Jesus needs to know "how, whether he will or not, he is even now deciding upon which side of the controversy he will be found." (ibid.).

Through fallen churches and political legislation, the arch enemy uses deception and persecution to try to force the whole human race to join his rebellion against God (Rev 12:9, 13, 17; *UL* 262) and thus deprive Jesus of the joyful reward of His self-sacrifice on Calvary (Isa 53:11; Heb 12:2; *GC* 647, 652, 671; *DA* 680). God, however, through preaching the gospel and compassionate service to suffering humanity, uses truth and love to draw all people to Jesus as their crucified Savior (Jn 12:32; *DA* 759), gives them repentance and forgiveness (Ac 5:31), saves them by grace through faith (Eph 2:8), and makes them children of God and joint-heirs with Christ of His everlasting kingdom (Rom 8:14-17).

In the second battle of the Great Controversy, Christ's death exposed Satan as a liar and murderer (Jn 8:44; *DA* 57), and so defeated him and destroyed his works (Heb 2:14; 1 Jn 3:8). In the fourth battle, "this last conflict of the great controversy" (*PK* 627), the faithful remnant of God's people again will overcome Satan "by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death." (Rev 12:11; 2SM 380). Thus, God is revealed and vindicated in His true character of just, merciful, selfless love, first personally and decisively in the physical body of His Son, and now corporately and globally through the spiritual body of Christ, His church (Eph 3:10-11).

God's people overcome Satan in this final battle only as they take seriously that his own nature is expressed on both the corporate level, in fallen Babylon, which has received her "power, seat, and great authority" from him (Rev 13:12), and on the personal level, in the human heart (Jer 17:9). They are determined to fight the battle on both levels: By coming out and staying clear of Babylon (Rev 18:4; 14:4), the "beast without", they overcome confusion and error; and by repentance from dead works and spiritual pride (Rev 3:1-3, 17-19), they overcome sin and selfishness, the "beast within." They clearly recognize that overcoming on both levels is essential to their salvation (Mt 24:9-13; Rev 2 & 3).

Moreover, God's remnant people know that staying away from institutions led by Satan, his "power without", is not the whole battle, since Satan's "power within" must also be overcome (COL 174-175). Martin Luther is quoted as confessing, "I fear the pope self more than I fear the pope of Rome." (Eli Wigle, Prevailing Prayer, Continental Publishing, 1900, p. 75). "A man may be baptized, and his name placed on church rolls, yet his heart may be unchanged. Hereditary and cultivated tendencies may still work evil in the character." (UL 182). Even true believers may still have "corrupt and sinful habits that must be overcome by vigorous warfare. Every soul is required to fight the fight of faith." (6BC 1111).

Will God's people choose to fight the Great Controversy on both levels and strive to overcome in the victorious nature of their Savior and Lord? Will they help other people understand the Great Controversy and how they can participate in the total victory over sin and error? Will they fight the good fight of faith to the very end and remain faithful until Jesus comes to take them home (1 Ti 6:12; Rev 2:10)?

SUMMARY: Lastly, you identify the powers in the final crisis, and your duty calling for absolute loyal love to Jesus, if you are to share in His victory.

"As God's people approach the final crisis, they must with increasing power proclaim the message He has given them... God's requirements must be laid before those who are transgressing His law. They must be made to understand that this is a life and death question. God's remnant people are to fill the earth with the cry of the third angel." (*RH 07-16-1901*). "The great crisis is just before us. To meet its trials and temptations, and to perform its duties, will require persevering faith. But we may triumph gloriously; not one watching, praying, believing soul will be ensnared by the enemy." (*6T 404*).

Who of God's people are properly preparing for the final crisis as depicted in Rev 17, so they can share in Christ's final victory? Only those who keep all His commandments from loyal loving faith in Him (Jn 14:15; Rev 3:18). We must remember: "The great controversy going on in the world is waging more sharply today than at any period of the world's history..." (*UL 20*). Satan "knoweth that he hath but a short time" (Rev 12:12).

A. Sound the Trumpet - 2. Stand on the Side of Truth - 201. The Two Last Day Movements

SUMMARY: Second, you need complete self-denial in the final crisis to persevere against the satanic counterfeit of the Three Angels' Messages.

"Before the final visitation of God's judgments upon the earth there will be among the people of the Lord such a revival of primitive godliness as has not been witnessed since apostolic times. The Spirit and power of God will be poured out upon His children....The enemy of souls desires to hinder this work; and before the time for such a movement shall come, he will endeavor to prevent it by introducing a counterfeit....There will be manifest what is thought to be great religious interest....Under a religious guise, Satan will seek to extend his influence over the Christian world....Yet none need be deceived. In the light of God's word it is not difficult to determine the nature of these movements." (*GC 464*).

"Two great opposing powers are revealed in the last great battle. On one side stands the Creator of heaven and earth. All on His side bear His signet. They are obedient to His commands. On the other side stands the prince of darkness, with those who have chosen apostasy and rebellion." (7BC 982). "Between the laws of men and the precepts of Jehovah will come the last great conflict of the controversy between truth and error. Upon this battle we are now entering--a battle not between rival churches contending for the supremacy, but between the religion of the Bible and the religions of fable and tradition. The agencies which have united against truth are now actively at work." (PK 625).

The last days of earth's history are of unprecedented spiritual import and impact. Movements of both divine and satanic origins and power are now gathering followers by drawing them into their ranks to get ready for the battle of Armageddon (Rev 16:13-14). Being initiated by opposite spirits, they will necessarily and very soon be on an open collision course (Rev 12:17). By the time probation closes, the human race will have been divided into two distinct and fixed groups with opposite eternal destinies (Rev 22:11). Only those who remain on God's side will finally be saved (Mt 24:13; Rev 2:11). The time is urgent. "Church and state are now making preparations for the last great conflict." (RH 01-23-1908).

Are we making our preparations, both individually and corporately? God is calling on His remnant people now to give humanity, in the power of the latter rain, His final invitation to receive the gospel (Rev 14:6-7; 18:4; 22:17), and His last warning of the tragic results of rejecting it (Rev 14:8-11). The faith of all people will be tested (Rev 3:10; *GC* 560, 605). Already many depart from it and are shaken out (1 Ti 4:1; Heb 12:27), while others purpose their refining and renewing (Mal 3:2; Rev 3:18). "The Lord is calling for self-denying workers to follow in His footsteps, to walk and work for Him...." (8T 28). His probing question is: Will we persevere in the self-denial needed to stand on the side of truth (Lk 18:8)?

A. Sound the Trumpet – 2. Stand on the Side of Truth – 202. The End-Time Elijah

SUMMARY: Here you can see how, by spreading these messages, you help prepare a people for the Lord as did Elijah and John the Baptist.

The prophetic Three Angels' Messages preached in the power of Holy Spirit (Rev 14:6-12; 18:1-4), directly contradict the three demons' messages of the counterfeit trinity (Rev 16:13). As both messages go out to and gather followers from the whole world (Rev 14:6; 16:14), the great controversy between Christ and Satan comes to a climax in the spiritual "Battle of Armageddon" (Rev 16:14-16). Christ, the true High Priest (Heb 6:20) and King of kings (Rev 17:14), and His followers of pure faith, His virgin bride (Rev 14:4; 19:7-9), fight against prostitute Babylon, which is posing as a High Priest (Rev 17:4-5; Ex 28; 39) and a queen (Rev 18:7), and her followers of corrupt faith, her illicit lovers (Rev 17:1-2, 14).

"Armageddon" means "mountain of Megiddo", but there is no mountain by that name, nor was Megiddo itself on a mountain. However, the city is reminiscent of two decisive historic battles: Israel's dramatic victory over Canaanite kings "by the waters of Megiddo" (Jdg 4; 5:19), and Elijah's victory over the priests of Baal on nearby Mount Carmel (1 Ki 18:16-46). Both battles are types of the two aspects of the Battle of Armageddon: 1. As God gave His people of Israel physical victory over kings at Megiddo (Jdg 5:19), so Christ assures His remnant people that when He comes He will destroy the "kings of the earth" and Babylon, which had united to destroy them (Rev 6:14-17; 16:18-21; 17:14-16; 19:19-21).

2. But before "that great day of God Almighty" (Rev 16:14), a <u>spiritual</u> victory is to be gained, a decision secured: As on Mount Carmel the prophet Elijah called the Israelites to follow the true God, so in the Battle of Armageddon God's remnant, through the prophetic Three Angels' Messages (Rev 16:14-16; 18:1-4), calls the end-time world to worship Him. Carmel and Armageddon urge the same decision: Who will you follow or worship, the true Creator God or an idol (1 Ki 18:21; Rev 13:8; 14:7)? It is a matter of life or death (1 Ki 18:37-40; Rev 19:19-21; 20:15). By calling everyone on earth to worship God, "for the hour of His judgment is come" (Rev 14:6), God's remnant acts as His end-time Elijah (7T 141).

This is still our mission. "Thousands were led to embrace the truth preached by William Miller, and servants of God were raised up in the spirit and power of Elijah to proclaim the message." (*EW 233; 1SG 133*). "Those who are to prepare the way for the second coming of Christ are represented by faithful Elijah, as John came in the spirit of Elijah to prepare the way for Christ's first advent. The work of John the Baptist, and the work of those who in the last days go forth in the spirit and power of Elijah to arouse the people from their apathy, are in many respects the same." (*Mar 22*). It is to globally "make straight the way of the Lord" (Isa 40:3-5; Mt 3:3) by making "ready a people prepared for the Lord" (Lk 1:17).

A. Sound the Trumpet – 2. Stand on the Side of Truth – 203. The Comings of the Two Christs

SUMMARY: You also prepare yourself and others for the Lord's return, as you discern Satan's deception when he counterfeits Jesus' coming.

The second coming of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ has been the "blessed hope" (Tit 2:13) of all true believers who have looked for their final deliverance for centuries (Da 12:1; Heb 11:39-40; Mt 6:10). As this most climactic event of earth's history is drawing closer, Satan knows he has but a short time left (Rev 12:12) to achieve his devious goal to deceive the whole human race into deifying him instead of worshipping the Creator (Isa 14:13-15; Mt 4:9; *LDE 168*). He will attempt this, not just by claiming to be the Christ as many others have before him (Mt 24:5), but by actually personating Him, thereby counterfeiting the coming of the true Christ (2 Th 2:9; *LDE 162-164*).

This will be Satan's greatest delusion, the "crowning act in the drama of deception" (*GC* 624), by which he will mislead almost all the people of the world and attempt to deceive, if it were possible, even the very elect (Mt 24:24). However, the elect are able to discern Satan's trickery. They know that he is not permitted to counterfeit the manner of Jesus' coming and the events associated with it (*LDE* 165-166). They have identified the exact points by which to distinguish between the genuine and the false Christ, and are committed to endure to the end and patiently wait for their true great God and Savior (Mt 24:13; Isa 64:4; 25:9; Tit 2:13), even if they are in the minority (*5T* 136).

God's remnant people look for the glorious future, which their divine Lord has prepared for those who love Him (1 Co 2:9; Jas 2:5). That is why, in the power of the latter rain, they faithfully and powerfully proclaim the true Savior and the true Sabbath, calling people out of Babylon (Rev 18:1-4). This constitutes "the final warning to be given to the inhabitants of the earth." (*GC* 604).

A. Sound the Trumpet – 3. Qualify for the Seal of God – 301. The Purposes and Phases of the Sealing

SUMMARY: Third, you need perpetual abiding in Jesus through His Spirit, since without Him you cannot qualify for or benefit from His sealing.

The sealing of God's faithful people is the means by which the Lord achieves His divine plan for them (Isa 55:11; Jer 27:11).

A seal is a literal impression on a document (Est 3:12) or a spiritual sign for its recipients (Ex 31:13). It contains the name, title, and jurisdiction of its author, thereby declares the authority of the owner, and gives authority to the messenger to share and act on the message.

In the Scriptures any sealing has three purposes. They apply to the written document such as a letter or a book, to a message such as a law to be proclaimed, as well as to its messenger. This is particularly true for the Ten Commandments and God's people in the last days.

The sealing of God's people is not simply a single one-time occurrence, but a process in four phases. It comes at crucial points in their lives, and will be completed only on the faithful who endure unto the end and are then delivered and saved (Da 12:1; Mt 24:13; Mk 13:13).

Who of God's people are committed to qualify for all stages of the sealing?



A. Sound the Trumpet – 3. Qualify for the Seal of God – 302. Events of the Time of the End

SUMMARY: Only as you abide in Jesus and are sealed, can you remain faithful through the prophesied sequence of the rapid final events.

"We are living in the time of the end. The fast-fulfilling signs of the times declare that the coming of Christ is near at hand." (9T 11).

Time of Preparation → Sunday Law

- (1) Third Angel's Message: Given from 1844 (EW 254) to close of probation (GC 613). Embraces the 1st & 2nd messages (8T 197). 1888: Righteousness by Faith is "3rd angel's message in verity" (LDE 199), commanded by God "to be given to the world." (TM 92).
- (2) <u>Sealing: Settling into the truth</u> (4BC 1161 on Rev 7:2): <u>Prepares</u> believers for shaking and the Latter Rain (*Mar, chs.192 & 193*).
- (3) Counterfeit Revivals: In fallen churches, before Loud Cry (EW 261). Started by Satan to prevent the coming true revival (GC 464).
- (4) <u>True Revival/Reform</u>: Among God's people. Has 2 phases; 1st is prerequisite for 2nd: 1. Enabled by Former Rain (*LDE 187-196*). 2. Enabled by Latter Rain (*9T 126*; *GC 464*).
- (5) Shaking Time: Already begun (4BC 1161). Caused by straight testimony (LDE 175), false theories (LDE 177) & persecution (173-4).
- (6) US & Global Sunday Laws: Image to beast & death threat (Rev 13:15-17; GC 445; 6T 18). Final test for humanity (Rev 14:12; GC 605).

Little Time of Trouble → Close of Probation

- (7) Satan works miracles & disasters (GC 588-9). Sunday Law (Rev 13:16-17; GC 449; 604-5). Believers persecuted (GC 607-8): scatters, unifies, sanctifies (6T 401; LDE 145-154). Satan counterfeits 2nd Coming (GC 625).
- (8) <u>Latter Rain</u> (Joel 2:23; Ac 3:19; *EW* 86): Swells 3rd angel's message to <u>Loud Cry</u> (Rev 18:1-4; *EW* 277). Prepares believers for plagues (*EW* 86), fits them for translation (1T 187). <u>Final warning</u> heeded; unconverted shaken out & replaced (4T 89; GC 604-612).
- (9) Seal of the living God (Eze 9:2-4; Rev 7:1-3; EW 38, 48): All who fully reflect the image of Christ (EW 71) & truly keep Sabbath (GC 640). Their sins blotted out (Ac 3:19; GC 485, 620). Protected from 7 last plaques (EW 43, 71).
- (10) Marriage of the Lamb: Christ receives His kingdom (Da 7:13-14; GC 428, 480) in the Most Holy Place (EW 251, 280). Believers attend by faith (Mt 25:10; GC 427-428).
- (11) Close of probation: Holy Spirit withdrawn, door of mercy shut (Rev 22:11; GC 428, 614).

Great Time of Trouble → 2nd Coming

- (12) The 7 last plagues (GC 614). During 2nd:
 Death decree against the remnant starts time of Jacob's trouble (GC 615-620). Saints are protected, will not die (EW 283; GC 629-631).
 During 6th: Battle of Armageddon (Rev 16:16).
- (13) During 7th: Special Resurrection (Da 12:2; Mt 26:64) of all who pierced Christ (Rev 1:7), derided and opposed Him the most (GC 637), and all who died in the faith of the third angel's message, to behold Him coming in His glory, with terror (Rev 6:16) or joy (LDE 271-278).
- (14) Second Coming (Da 12:1): Death decree not executed, but Christ delivers saints at midnight (GC 636). The 144,000 receive "His seal of final triumph" (AG 200). The wicked are destroyed (Jer 25:33), the dead saints raised and the living translated; all meet Jesus in the air to ever be with Him (1 Th 4:15-17).
- "And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh." (Lk 21:28)

For the perfecting of the saints... Eph 4:12

A. Sound the Trumpet – 1. Awake to Our Present Time – 107. The Four Battles of the Great Controversy

SUMMARY: Now, look closer at Satan's rebellion: he fights on three levels. Rev 12 describes the cosmic level as four battles. Jesus wins them all.

Every student of the Bible is called to "gain a knowledge of its grand central theme, of God's original purpose for the world, of the rise of the great controversy, and of the work of redemption. He should understand the nature of the two principles that are contending for supremacy, and should learn to trace their working through the records of history and prophecy, to the great consummation. He should see how this controversy enters into every phase of human experience; how in every act of life he himself reveals the one or the other of the two antagonistic motives; and how, whether he will or not, he is even now deciding upon which side of the controversy he will be found." (Ed 190).

In short, the Great Controversy, this "unrelenting war between God and Satan," is fought on three levels, on the "cosmic and the personal levels" (12BC 969), and on the corporate level of both political and spiritual powers. Thus, the age-old conflict provides the Biblical key to the history of nations and religions and their interactions with God's people. Revelation 12 outlines the cosmic level in four major battles. Satan fights against Christ in direct and often unseen confrontations, both in heaven (Rev 12:7; Job 1:6-12) and on earth (Jude 9; Da 10:13; Mt 4:1-11; 16:23). Every one of these battles reveals Jesus and His faithful ones (angelic and human) as overcoming Satan and his followers.

This means, "The last great conflict between truth and error [the fourth battle] is but the final struggle of the long-standing controversy concerning the law of God. Upon this battle we are now entering - a battle between the laws of men and the precepts of Jehovah, between the religion of the Bible and the religion of fable and tradition. The agencies which will unite against truth and righteousness in this contest are now actively at work." (GC 582). Moreover, Satan is very angry with God's people, for he knows he has "but a short time." (Rev 12:12, 17). For this reason, "The great controversy going on in the world is waging more sharply today than at any period of the world's history..." (UL 20).

Are God's people ready for this final battle? And will they remain faithful to Jesus (Lk 18:8)?
